Annual Report 2018-2019

La Center Home School Academy had a student average of 22.1 FTEs and an average of 27.8 for head count with staff at 1.4 FTE. We had seven La Center School District 2019 graduates taking courses from LCHSA and four of them were full-time. Among those graduates were a fourth and a fifth year senior. We had fourteen students who committed to returning next year. LCHSA also had a total of six choice transfer students from either Ridgefield or Battle Ground.

LCHSA's K-8 students went on seven field trips this year that connected with their science and social studies units. Two of those field trips included exploring and discovering the importance of the La Center wetlands. LCHSA celebrates all students K-12+ that make satisfactory progress each month.

Odysseyware Online is still the main program being used for the elementary and middle school students. APEX is the main online program being used for the high school, while we also have Odysseyware Online for high school students that we believe would benefit from a different platform or are transitioning from 8th to 9th grade and feel more comfortable staying with the same online program. LCHSA is keeping an open mind and watching available online programs that are endorsed by the state to make sure we have the best program available for La Center School District.
