Annual Report 2019-2020

La Center Home School Academy had a student average of 35.25 FTEs and an average of 35.9 for head count with staff at 1.6 FTE. We had eleven La Center School District 2019 graduates taking courses from LCHSA and five of them were full-time. Among those graduates were five fourth year seniors and one fifth year senior. We had ten students who committed to returning next year. LCHSA also had a total of fourteen choice transfer students from either Ridgefield, Battle Ground or Kalama.

LCHSA's K-8 students were able to go on one field trip this year before COVID 19 hit. In December, we were able to have an educator from Mount Saint Helen's come and give an onsite presentation. Three other field trips that we had planned were cancelled because of the virus. Also before the virus hit, K-8 parents and students were meeting here at LCHSA every first Wednesday of the month to work on a science or art project.

Odysseyware Online is still the main program being used for the elementary and middle school students. APEX is the main online program being used for the high school, while we also have Odysseyware Online for high school students that we believe would benefit from a different platform or are transitioning from 8th to 9th grade and feel more comfortable staying with the same online program. LCHSA is keeping an open mind and watching available online programs that are endorsed by the state to make sure we have the best program available for La Center School District.
