## La Center Home School Academy

Annual Report 2020-2021

La Center Home School Academy had a student average of 120.08 FTEs and an average of 128.6 for head count with certificated staff at 3.5 FTE. We had 92 students who committed to returning next year. LCHSA also had a total of seventeen choice transfer students from either Ridgefield, Battle Ground, Vancouver, Green Mountain or Kalama.

LCHSA's K-8 students started with 61 students and by May had doubled in enrollment. The high school started with 47 students and by March added 67% more to it's enrollment. Thanks to Emily Parman and all the students she took on from February to June, we were able to accommodate students who needed to enroll in LCHSA with all the changes that were happening in the state and district.

Odysseyware Online is still the main program being used for elementary and middle school students for grades 3-8. Accelerate Learning is the program, as of January, we are using for grades K-2. APEX is the main online program being used for high school. LCHSA is keeping an open mind and watching available online programs that are endorsed by the state to make sure we have the best program available for La Center School District.
