May Counselor Lessons (In Math Classes)

6th Grade: College & Career: Income, Savings, and Spending

Students will learn the basics of different forms of income, types of savings accounts, and spending needs vs wants. Students will go through example budgets using different income levels and needed expenses. We will also touch on loans and credit cards and risks involved. **7th Grade:** <u>College & Career: Career Game & Exploration</u> Students will play a "You Don't Say" career game where they will get others to try and guess a career name without using certain descriptors. They will also explore some of the careers from the game on WA Career Bridge after playing. **8th Grade:** <u>College</u> <u>&Career: High School and Beyond Plan</u> Students will build their HS & Beyond plan using the classes they registered for already, other courses they plan to take at the high school, and think about what their goal is for after graduating high school in 4 years. This plan will be enhanced and modified throughout their time in high school.
